Zero21 IBAN account is an alternative to traditional bank accounts, providing increased efficiency and a digital approach to banking. IBAN stands for International Bank Account Number. This is a standardized number for bank accounts in most European countries, but also in many countries outside of Europe.

IBANs are formed in a standardized way, yet their length can vary due to the country's specifications. IBANs contain several components:

- » A country identifying code (according to ISO, a two-letter abbreviation of a specific country (e.g. LT - Lithuania, DE - Germany, etc))
- » IBAN check code (two digits number)
- » Account holder's bank identifier (BIC - Bank Identifier Code)
